KOL NIDREI

OPENING THE ARK

Standing before the open ark as Kol Nidrei begins symbolically opens the Gates of Heaven, inviting our prayers to be heard.

HOLDING THE TORAH (×3)

Parading the Torah so the community can draw close, forming a Bet Din of forgiveness for the Jewish people.

L'DAVID MIZMOR

OPENING THE ARK

Recited to acknowledge G-d's blessings on the year's holiest day — a segulah for prosperity and wealth.

TORAH READING · SHACHARIT

Monday, September 21, 2026 · Leviticus 16

PETICHA

OPENING THE ARK

Opening the ark before the Torah is removed for reading.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 1 · KOHEN

TORAH BLESSING

Recalls Aaron's sons, whose souls departed through excess spirituality — a symbol of atonement.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 2 · LEVI

TORAH BLESSING

The Kohen Gadol prays for his household and the tribe of Levi, sharing in that atonement.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 3 · SHLISHI

TORAH BLESSING

Aharon's scapegoat ceremony — casting lots and confessing the people's sins.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 4 · REV'I

TORAH BLESSING

“Who dwells among their impurity” — G-d dwells with us; the ultimate mission of a Jew.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 5 · CHAMISHI

TORAH BLESSING

Aaron confesses all of Israel's sins — this honor adds energy to our teshuva.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 6 · SHISHI

TORAH BLESSING

“This day itself atones for you” — the essence of Yom Kippur's atonement.

10 × CHAI

HAGBAH & GELILAH

LIFTING & WRAPPING

Elevates all the aliyot before it. Gelilah may be done by a boy under 13.

10 × CHAI

MAFTIR · HAFTARAH

TORAH BLESSING

Numbers 29:7–11, followed by the Haftarah from Isaiah — true repentance through kindness and charity.

MUSAF

UNETANEH TOKEF

OPENING THE ARK

The ark is opened for one of the most stirring compositions of the High Holy Days, written by Rabbi Amnon of Mainz nearly a thousand years ago.

MINCHA · BOOK OF JONAH

PETICHA

OPENING THE ARK

Opening the ark before the Mincha Torah reading.

10 × CHAI

ALIYAH 1 · KOHEN

TORAH BLESSING

The first aliyah of the Mincha service.

ALIYAH 2 · LEVI

TORAH BLESSING

The second aliyah of the Mincha service.

10 × CHAI

HAGBAH & GELILAH

LIFTING & WRAPPING

Elevates the Mincha aliyot. Gelilah may be done by a boy under 13.

NE'ILA

The closing service — the final gate before it closes

AVINU MALKEINU

BLESSING

Composed by Rabbi Akiva; central to our prayers in times of need.

MAFTIR YONA

TORAH BLESSING

The most important Aliyah of the day. Jonah's story of sincere repentance is a segulah for wealth. Awarded to a single bidder.

OPENING THE ARK

Our last chance to be heard before the gates close. Participants stand at the ark through Ne'ila and each receives a special blessing — a segulah for long life.
